July 1, 2014—June 30, 2015

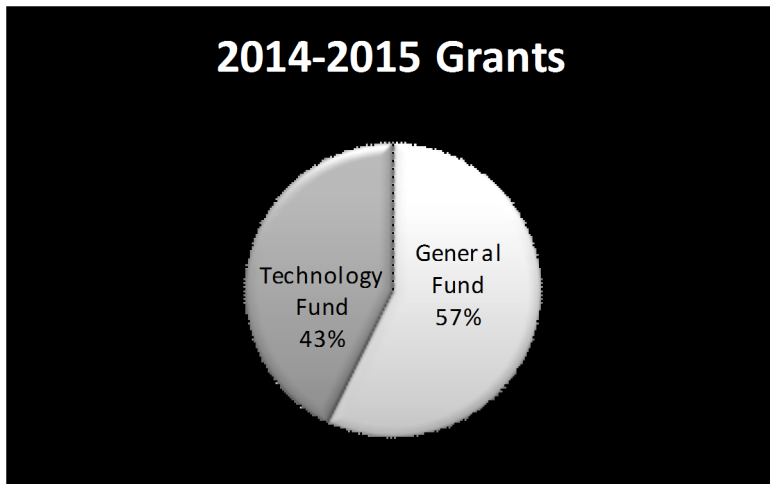
