Grants Activity to Date

Current Fiscal Year July 1, 2014—June 30, 2015

Since the beginning of the Fiscal Year on July 1, the Hancock Public Schools Foundation (HPSF) approved nearly \$60,000 in grant requests. Below are some highlights that illustrate the breadth of support across grade levels and disciplines:

- Completion of two sets of classroom novels for Grade 4 reading groups
- Replacement of two engine lathes for the Industrial Education Department
- Provision of a digital piano for the Music Department
- Funds for Elementary Grades Family Science and Engineering Night
- Continued support of Junior Library Guild subscription to benefit all students
- Replacement of preschool sandbox
- Continued support of the successful program BrainPop for elementary grades
- Career Cruising Career Planning Program-all grades
- Technology upgrade providing wireless access points in the Middle School and High School
