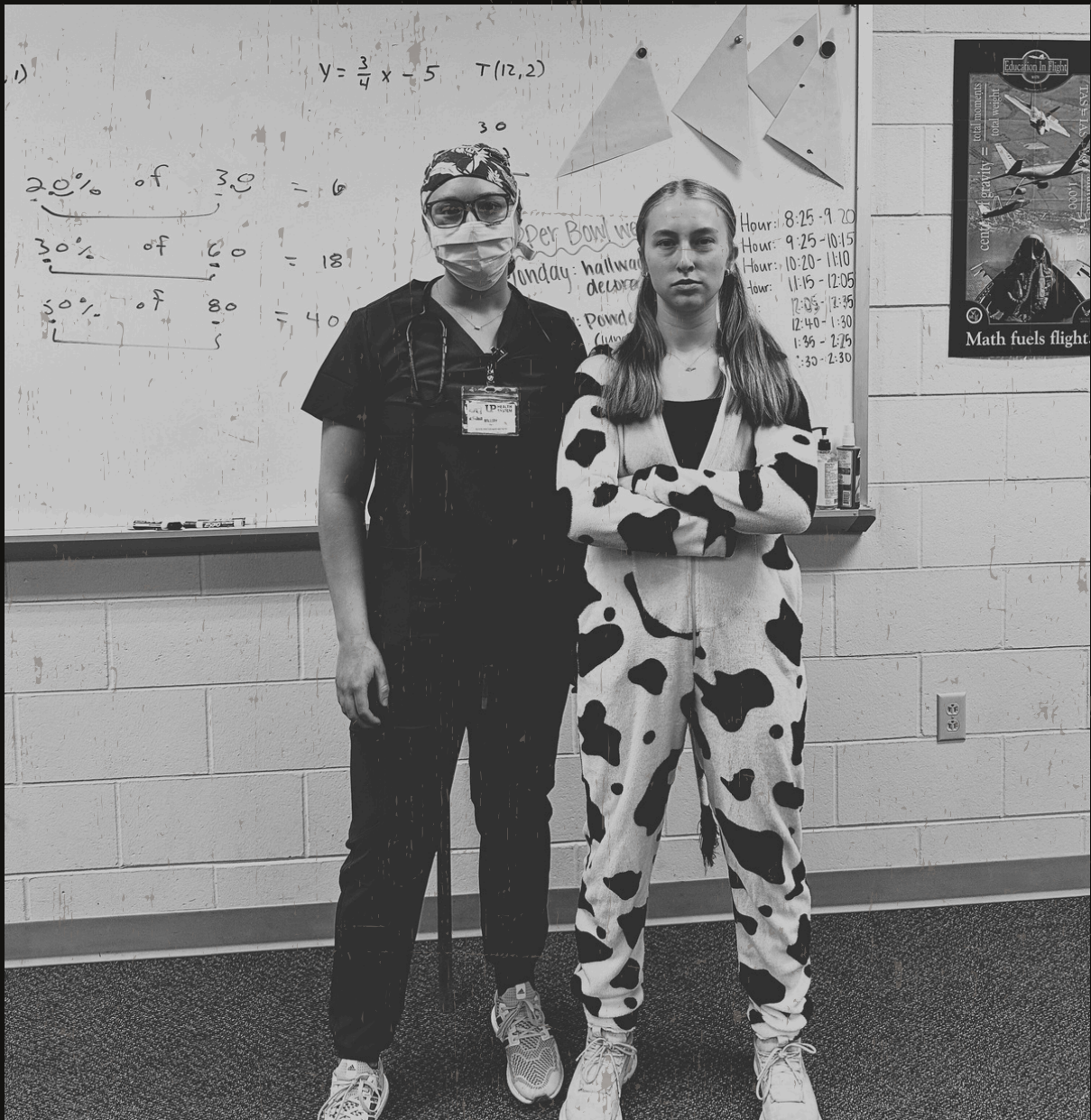

# CANDY REVIEW PEACH RINGS

Off brand vs name brand



The "Our Family" brand peach rings, found at the local Pat's Foods, have gained my attention lately. They're cheap and easy to find. However, how do they stack up against more popular or expensive brands? Going off of taste, texture, and overall experience, the Our Family peach rings offer a cheaper option, but there are a few areas where they either shine or fall short when compared to other brands. Our Family peach rings have provided a solid peachy flavor with a perfect balance of sweetness and tanginess. While the flavor is enjoyable, it lacks the intense fruitiness found in brands like Haribo or Albanese, which are known for their true-to-fruit flavors. These brands tend to use higher-quality ingredients, which are likely the cause of their more vibrant taste. For those who don't care for an extreme fruit flavor, and are okay with a milder taste, Our Family still satisfies, but it may not fully meet the cravings of candy aficionados looking for a more intense flavor. Texture is one area where Our Family peach rings differ notably. Compared to other leading brands, the Our Family peach rings are often softer and less chewy, which can be a good or bad thing based on someone's preferences. Haribo, for example, has a chewiness that many fans love, while Our Family peach rings are more tender. This might appeal to those who prefer a softer candy, but it could be a downside for those who expect the candy to offer a certain level of chewiness. The biggest appeal of Our Family peach rings is their price. They are typically more affordable than Haribo, Trolli, or Albanese, making them a great choice for people on a budget. Though they may not offer the same quality in flavor and texture, their low cost makes them an appealing option.

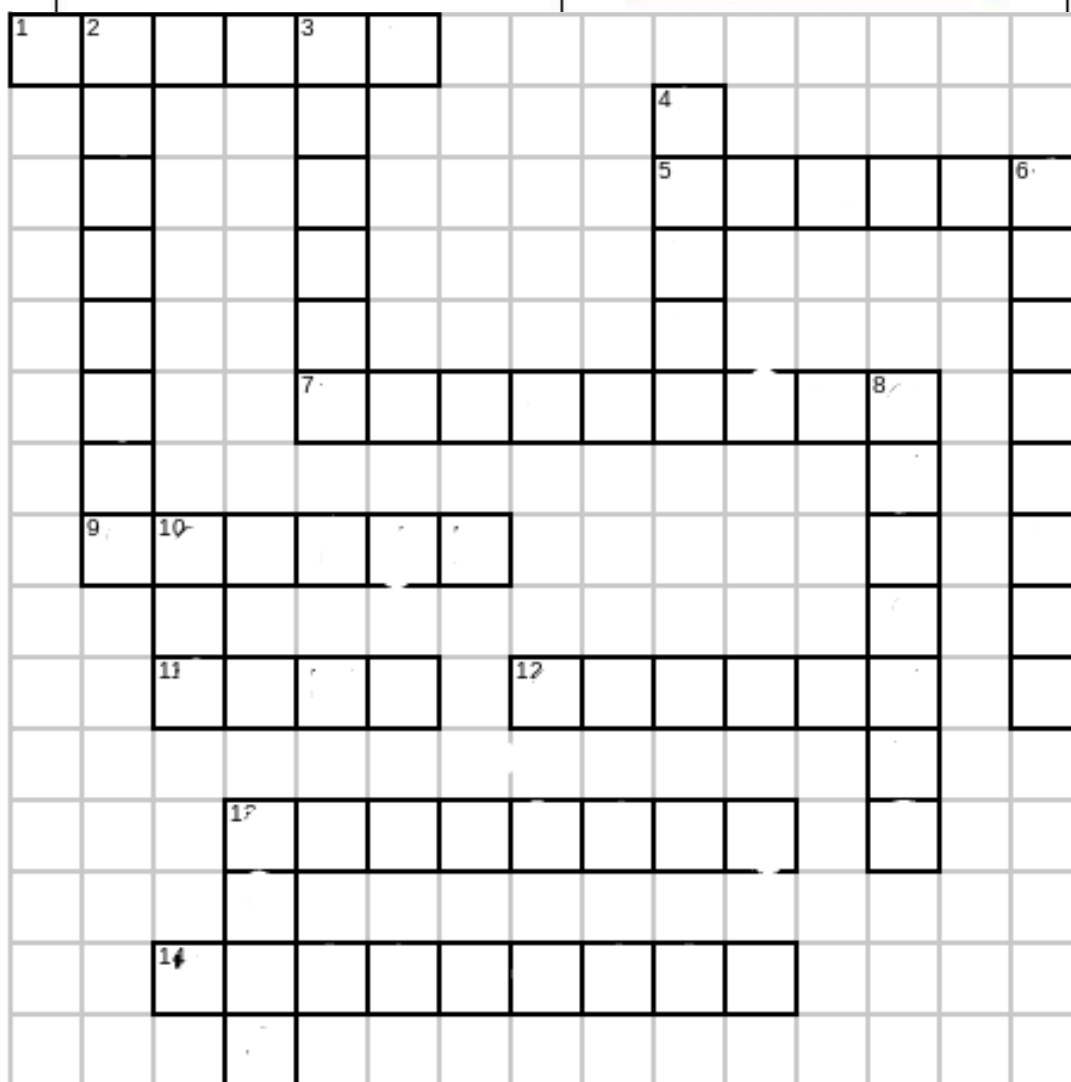

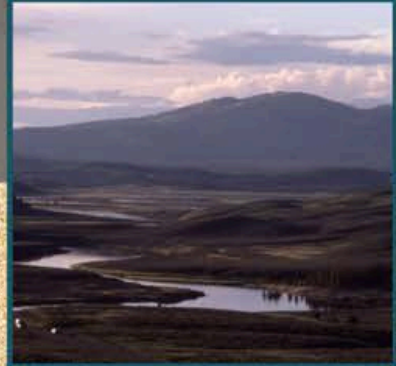

# The Fire Of 1869

On Sunday, April 11, 1869, there was a terrible fire in Hancock. It started early in the morning around 7:30 am. The fire had started in a small French saloon that had been connected to the Catholic Church and schools.

There was a dance all night long in the saloon, but when the wind-up of the stove had overturned, the contents had scattered all over the room. With no one attempting to put out the fire, the fire had gotten bigger, and everyone left the building. With the wind direction, the flames had gone wild. During this time, there was no fire department or fire equipment in Hancock. The fire went from building to building and house to house.

At six hours of the fire, there was not much left. It destroyed about 150 buildings. This had a loss of \$281,500 on the list of things they had lost from the fire, on which there was insurance to the amount of \$126,500.



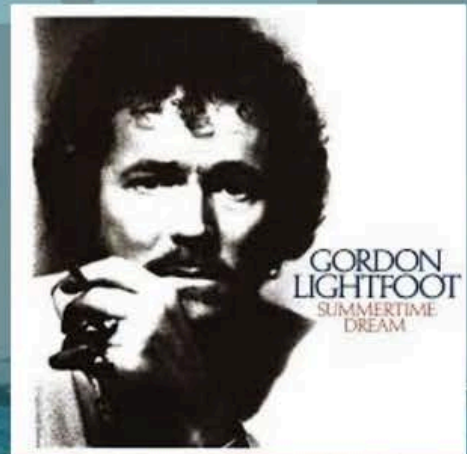


# The Edmund Fitzgerald

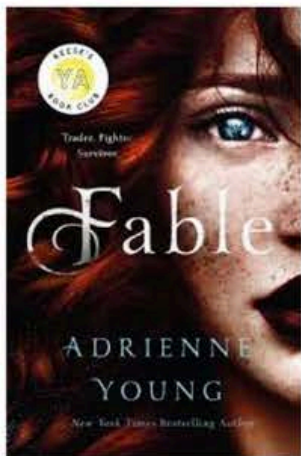
## AN AMERICAN HALLOWEEN

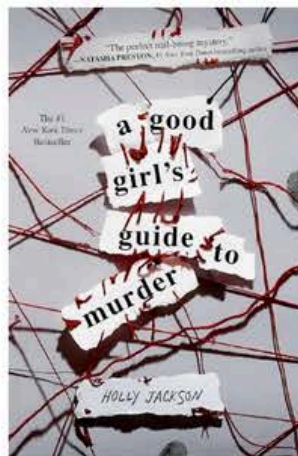

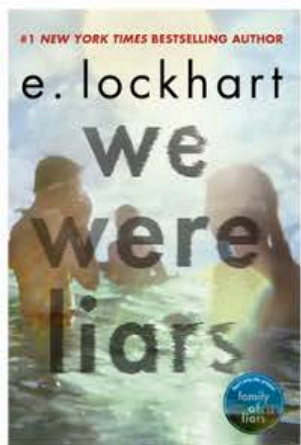
## Fable By Adrienne Young

Fable is about a young girl trying to survive a world created for men. She travels from place to place creating new friends and enemies. If you like fantasy books this is a great book to entertain you.



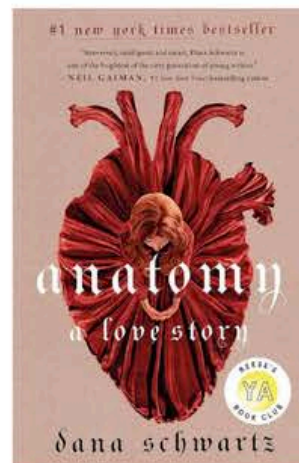
## A Good Girl's Guide to Murder By Holly Jackson

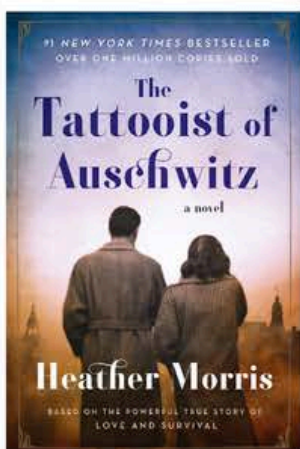
## We Were Liars BY E. Lockhart

## Daily Bugle

The Daily Bugle Lego set is a 3772-piece Lego set that you can buy for around \$350 (Amazon price). The set is inspired by the Daily Bugle building in Marvel's Spiderman comics and movies. It has 24 mini-figures consisting of your favorite Spiderman heroes and villains. The building has four floors to it, fully decorated inside and out. The way the build is designed allows you to be able to separate the different floors with ease and take off the front wall to better see the inside. With the many mini-figures, you can recreate your favorite scenes from the movies, or create your own battle between the heroes and villains. Lots of small details all over this set making it truly a great set

The Spiderman Final Battle Lego set is inspired by the movie, "Spiderman No Way Home". With this 900-piece set, you can recreate the final fight between the iconic Spiderman villains and all three Spidermen. The build has 9 mini-figures and the battle takes place on the head of the Statue of Liberty. You can relive the moment of watching the movie every time you look at this set, for only the price of \$110. This set has lots of hidden secrets like a Doctor Strange portal in the back of the Statue of Liberty's head, or Sand Man in the crown.



## Spiderman Final Battle

The Venomized Groot set is a 630-piece set that takes the beloved character of Baby Groot and puts a twist on him. Taking inspiration from Lego's already existing regular Groot Lego set, the set shows what Groot would look like if he were infected with the Venom symbiote. This set is actually a 2 in 1 set, the first design shows Groot almost fully venomized, with part of his face showing, and then a full venom version. Groot's limbs are fully opposable so you can have your Venom Groot in any fun position you want.
